




Documenting International & Military Addresses

As you move through this document, keep an open definition of the term “country”. While they are not all independent countries they are classified as such for the purposes of this field in Elite.

When documenting addresses with the following countries:


- United States
- American Samoa
- Federated States of Micronesia
- Guam
- Marshall Islands
- Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands
- Palau
- Puerto Rico
- U.S. Virgin Islands


Enter a Zip Code and use the  button

When documenting an international address not in the list above:

Change  to the appropriate value

Enter street address in  304 Newton Barracks Rd

Enter City/State, etc. in  Belize City, Belize

When Documenting Military Addresses (APO/FPO):

Scroll to bottom of section and select YES

Use first line for info incl. ship name & hull number, if aboard a vessel

Use second line for "City" "State" and Zip

Patient Home Address
2nd Line:

FPO AE 09565

* FPO is associated with Navy ships and installations. APO is associated with Army or Air Force installations. These are used in lieu of the City.

* AE/AP/AA denotes the region (Europe, Pacific, Americas) and is used in lieu of the State.

When documenting for a patient whose address is not known and cannot be identified:

Enter UNKNOWN (all caps) in the 1st line of Home Address

Patient's Home Address:

UNKNOWN

This will clear all remaining validation
